

Next Meeting:

- VPP Suite Funding Michael noted that most all of the agencies using the VPP Suite have committed to paying for it. He expressed his sincere thanks.

Questions:

- 1. Mena Lockwood, VDOT: Will the NPMRDS freight data also be available?
 - a. Yes, freight data will be available as part of the NPMRDS in the suite
- 2. Ira Levinton, NJDOT: Do agencies have access to data from multiple vendors?
 - a. In the suite, for your state, you only have access to the data purchased by your state.
 - b. Ira had questions regarding selecting by county/selecting by partial roadway. John is following up with Ira offline.
- 3. Jim Hadden, NJDOT: How far back does the NPMRDS go?
 - a. VPP Suite has entire data set.
 - b. Per Mike Bruff (NCDOT): NPMRDS data on the FHWA/HERE website is available in archive form dating back to 2011 for Interstates, and the full data set has been available since July 2013. New monthly data sets are released two weeks after the end of the previous month.
- 4. Mike Bruff, NCDOT: For the NPMRDS data, can the date and time stamp field be disaggregated into two separate fields or split with a comma delineation?
 - a. Yes
- 5. Ram Venkatanarayana, VCTIR/VDOT: For NPMRDS data, when data is not available, how is backfilling done for measures like Reliability?
 - a. There are several different options but there has not been consensus on how this should be done; looking for additional guidance from USDOT/FHWA when a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM) is issued.

Requests/Issues:

- 1. Saving/Showing Parameters
 - a. Kelly Wells, NCDOT: Requested other parameters be saved, similar to TMC sets.
 - b. Ram Venkatanarayana, VCTIR/VDOT: When using the congestion scan, Time of Day is not clear on some Congestion Scans. This becomes especially difficult when running multiple scans. In ongoing discussions, John noted that this may be part of a larger issue/request for having a full summary of query information clearly indicated on any output.
 - c. Ram Venkatanarayana, VCTIR/VDOT: Requested that input variables be provided with output.
 - d. Kelly Wells, NCDOT: Requested having the choice to use military or regular time.



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2. Reliability Thresholds

- a. Paul Szatkowski, VDOT: They are using reliability for prioritizing projects. He has been asked to provide data for various thresholds and wanted to know if that would be available. Michael noted that they are working to allow users to select thresholds however, the policy implications need to be considered.
- b. Kelly Wells, NCDOT: They are also looking to prioritize projects similarly but they do not have VPP data for secondary roads. Paul noted VDOT has a similar issue and they are looking at comparing with roads (with similar characteristics) where VPP data is available. Stan Young (NREL) mentioned that data was not purchased for secondary roads. It was noted that they could prepare performance reports through the INRIX site using the XD data. Michael noted that the VPP Suite could take in the vendors' sub-segment data if a state was willing to pay for the storage. He also noted that each vendor segments this level of data differently. With some development, it should also be possible to use both the sub-segmented data and the TMC data in the Suite assuming an agency is willing to pay for it.

3. MAP-21

- a. Zoe Neaderland, DVRPC: Would be interested in coordinating on a response when MAP-21 NPRM comes out. It was mentioned that the User Group Forum thread could be used to collect comments from agencies. Zoe noted that there are two levels to be considered – policy and technical. She suggested a joint webinar. George Schoener agreed that the Coalition would work with the agencies and the Partners Using Archived Data on a coordinated response.
- b. Michael Pack noted that they plan to have a version of the VPP Suite with the MAP-21 measures operational during the comment period so that agencies can see how the measures work with their data and develop comments.

4. XD User Focus Group

a. Consideration was being given to forming an XD User Focus Group, addressing such issues as how to start/end your selection (related to intersections), how do users want to see the data in the interface, etc. Kelly Wells was to consider leading that group.
